A Constitution is a written set of rules that guide the operation of an incorporated association. The constitution outlines the following:

- Operations of the organisation and the Executive Committee;
- Members rights; and
- Meeting protocols.

How can I change OUR ORGANISATION CONSTITUTION? To change your organisations Constitution you need to follow the below process:

- 1. Pass a special resolution at a general committee meeting regarding the change in Constitution; and
- 2. Within 3 months of passing this resolution, the secretary must lodge an Associations Incorporation Form 8 -Application to register an amendment of rules to the Office of Fair Trading.
